To make an application through UCAS you will need to go to www.ucas.com. You will need to register on UCAS before you can submit any choices. There are many helpful guides on the UCAS website. We encourage you to use these guides if you are experiencing any difficulties.

UCAS FEES

There is a cost for submitting a UCAS application. The cost depends on how many course choices you wish to apply for. These costs are payable direct to UCAS.

APPLICANTS GUIDE TO UCAS

UCAS DEADLINES

THE DEADLINE FOR ON TIME UCAS APPLICATIONS TO BE RECEIVED IS THE **15TH JANUARY 2019 AT 18:00 GMT**. ANY SUBMITTED AFTER THIS DATE WILL BE CONSIDERED AS 'LATE' APPLICATIONS BY UCAS.

This means that we don't have to consider an application if it is received after this date – on time applications will be prioritised. However, we will look at all applications received up until the **30th June 2019 at 18:00 GMT**.

WHAT TO INCLUDE IN YOUR UCAS APPLICATION

Academic Qualifications

Please make sure you list all your academic achievements. Please also list any pending qualifications.

If you are mature applicant (19+) who does not hold the academic entry criteria we can consider you for APEL (Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning).

Personal Statement

You must include a personal statement with your UCAS application. There is a guide to writing a personal statement on the UCAS website: www.ucas.com/ucas/undergraduate/getting-started/when-apply/writing-personal-statement

Please write your statement in a word document so that you can check your spelling and grammar and then simply copy and paste it into the personal statement section on your UCAS application. There is a maximum of 4000 characters. Please use paragraphs within your statement as this makes it clearer to read. We advise that you keep a copy of your personal statement.

Reference

You will need to supply a reference with your application. Ideally this should be a teacher or tutor at your school/college. If you are no longer in education and are working, please provide a reference from your employer.

Offer of a place

If your assessment/interview is successful, you will be made one of two offers: Conditional OR Unconditional.

If your offer is conditional it means it will be pending BIMM receiving any further information that is required, such as exam results and certificates. If it is unconditional then you have met the entry criteria for the course and do not need to supply any additional information. Offers for Degree level courses can only be made if you have submitted your UCAS application. If you have not yet applied through UCAS please do so as soon as possible. This will allow us to process your offer as quickly as possible. All offers for places on courses will be made through 'Track' on UCAS. This is where you will need to confirm if you wish to take your place.

If your application is unsuccessful it means that you may not have passed the assessment/interview at the appropriate level or you have not met the academic entry criteria. If there is a specific reason for your application being unsuccessful it will be noted on 'Track'.

International Applicants

International applicants that are not able to attend an assessment in person will need to complete one remotely. Guidelines on what to do will be provided when we have received your application.
