

Ngoc Anh Nguyen (AKA ANOTHER NGUYEN) graduated from our Songwriting degree in 2020.

Today she works freelance fulltime. Working across a number of different projects, there's one uniting force: music. Yet, it wasn't always clear that music would play such a pivotal role in Ngoc Anh's career. We took the chance to sit down with her and discover her path into the creative industries.

Tell us about yourself.

I'm Ngoc Anh Nguyen and I'm a singer, songwriter, and social worker. Growing up as the daughter of working class, Vietnamese immigrants, a career in music was never really on the table. No one around me worked in music so it wasn't an option I'd ever considered growing up.

My career started out in a different world: social work. It was what first brought me to Berlin, and it remains a huge part of what has kept me here. While I was training, I was involved in lots of other activities including Viet-German political and community networks, acapella and even swing dance. But my favourite thing to do was going to concerts. I loved the international crowd I'd meet at shows, and I always dreamt of being up on stage.

Eventually, I spent enough time going to gigs that I just couldn't wait any longer. So, I applied to BIMM and my life completely shifted. Now I perform in the same venues I used to hang out in, and I'm more part of Berlin's international creative scene than I ever could have imagined.

What does your career look like at the moment?

Right now, I'm working freelance across a number of different projects. My main gig is my solo project, ANOTHER NGUYEN. I make what I like to call "empowering electro-pop". I'm currently working towards the release of my second EP, alongside doing session work with artists like Kat Frankie.

With my background in social work, I also work on projects that combine that experience with music. The big one right now is a film project called *Dreh*'s *Um* that aims to teach young Vietnamese-Germans filmmaking skills. While I first got involved as a social worker, I'm now focused on developing and growing the project. For instance, we're now doing music videos, which is new for the project.

Your EP sounds super exciting! Can you tell us a bit more about

I've been working on it for around a year now and it's due to come out in November 2023. Once it's out I'll also play a headline show at Badehaus on the R.A.W Gelände. It'll be surreal to play there as it's where my performance classes were back in the day. I'll be playing my new stuff with a full band so it'll be a real full circle moment. The support act is even a fellow BIMM grad!

You've decided to stay in Berlin long after graduating. What is about the city that keeps you here?

I've just never got bored! I feel like the city has given me the opportunity to continuously

evolve in a really positive way. I don't just have to be one thing here: I can intertwine my passion for social work and music because that's who I am.

Plus, the creative community here is amazing. While Berlin has so many opportunities in the entertainment business, it's still got this rawness that's very human. For example, even when I had only just graduated, I got this opportunity through BIMM to be featured in a video portrait for Sennheiser. It just goes to show how good it is to maintain those BIMM connections once you graduate!

And to round us off, what advice would you give to someone thinking about studying at **BIMM University Berlin?**

The first thing I would say is that you have to remember that you're in this for the long run. It's okay to pause and not always push.

For me, everything only really started after I graduated. While I was studying I was just exploring. Everyone has their own tempo and it's okay to feel lost sometimes, so don't compare where you are to anyone else.

I also think it's super important to network both inside and outside of BIMM. You've got to be proactive to turn everything you do and learn at BIMM into a career. Get involved with as many projects as possible. Just seize every opportunity.

Creative industries in Berlin

For generations, creative institutions of all shapes and sizes have played an important role in the city's economy and cultural landscape. While many of the city's creative enterprises have been around for decades and longer, the city is also home to innovative and futuristic organisations that continually push the boundaries of creativity. The Berlinale

Without doubt, the Berlin International Film Festival (more commonly known as the Berlinale) is a highlight of Berlin's packed film calendar. Welcoming filmmakers and actors from across the globe, the festival prides itself on being a unique place of artistic exploration and entertainment. As one of the world's largest public film festivals, there are tonnes of opportunities to get involved - whether as a volunteer, an intern or simply as an audience member.



Founded in 2018, Endel is a sound wellness company that creates personalised soundscapes that help its users relax, focus, sleep and move. With AI technology at its core, Endel's mission is to democratise wellness by making it accessible to all. As part of this effort, Endel signed a distribution deal with Warner Music Group to release 20 albums created by algorithms and have also collaborated with internationally renowned acts like Grimes, James Blake and 6LACK.



Volksbühne

Without doubt, Berlin's most iconic theatre, the Volksbühne (People's Theatre) is recognised worldwide as a leading European theatre. First opened in 1914, the theatre's founders wanted to make plays accessible to the common worker with prices that reflected that. Following this tradition, the Volksbühne today is known throughout the world for its ambitious, experimental, and often political productions.



Kolibri Games

Founded by a group of business and IT students back in 2016, Kolibri Games is one of Berlin's most successful home-grown games studios. Specialising in the idle games genre, they captured the attention of French gaming giant Ubisoft, who later acquired them in 2020. With over 250 million downloads across their portfolio of games, and a wealth of awards in their name, there's no doubt that Kolibri games are just getting started.





House of Music

It does what it says on the tin: House of Music is where you'll find our specialist facilities for everything related to the creation of music and sound. This is where film and game soundtracks are conceptualised, designed and developed, our future favourite songs are born, and where voice is recorded for podcast, documentary, video games and more.

Where music and sound calls home, House of Music is an iconic building in the Berlin creative scene. A real hub of Berlin's industry, the building appeals to companies of all shapes and sizes including iZotope, Shure and Yamaha. Plus, just a stone's throw across the River Spree, you'll find the offices of industry giants like Native Instruments and Universal Music. But that's not all. House of Music also lies within the RAW Gelände – a vibey, graffiti covered area full to the brim with art galleries and ateliers, music venues, skate halls, gyms, event spaces and more.

As a student with us, you'll become part of the wider forward-thinking community that BIMM is a part of, bringing your talents to put on display – whether on stage, on screen or behind the scenes.

Molecule Studios

As we grew up in the city, we needed a new space to play in. This space we now call Molecule Studios and it's where stories across stage and screen come to life. Within its walls, narratives and documentaries go from storyboard to shoot, green screens take us to locations out of this world, and we enter virtual realities at the touch of a button.

Molecule Studios is based in the Bouché Höfe complex, an area which has a long history of innovation within visual creation. Once home to AGFA – an early pioneer of technology for capturing image – our facilities here will get you ready to lead the next generation of forward-thinking creatives.

Alongside this inspiring history, you'll also rub shoulders with some of Berlin's brightest and most innovative creatives, thanks to the network of coworking spaces, post-production companies and recording studios in the area. And if all that hasn't got you sold, there's also Berlin's best falafel (our favourite, at least) just around the corner. What better place to expand your creative horizons?
